



## **CAMPING LACONELLA**

Located on different levels due to the morphology of the land, it has significant heights that could create difficulties for mobility.

Guests can use the beaten earth and gravel outdoor parking area, where there is a car park reserved for people in possession of a EU-disabled parking permit, about 20 meters from Reception. Car access for loading and unloading of luggage.

The toilet near Reception can be reached from the road via a steep slope (greater than 12%). It has a 49cm high wall-hung WC, with a shower and hand rails on both sides, with the possibility of approaching from the front and the right side; wall-hung washbasin and shower with foldable seat and horizontal hand rail.

The Restaurant and the Market can be reached by a ramp with a 19% gradient.

The restaurant is furnished with rectangular tables with a useful underneath space of 68 cm. The menu is multi-lingual, and it is possible to order dishes for children and vegetarians. The staff is able to provide information on the ingredients that make up the dishes.

The toilet has a WC with 51 cm high front access, with the possibility of approaching from the front and left side with a pull-down hand rail to the right; automatic light and suspended washbasin.

Organic products are available in the small market.

In the children's play area, near the car park, there are games, seats and a shaded area. The pavement is in beaten earth and sand.

There are 5 housing units available that are all the same, and access requires you to mount 4 steps.

The master bedroom, with an entrance of 59 cm, is furnished with a 57cm high movable bed with a maximum access of 38 cm, while the double bedroom, with an entrance of 52 cm, does not allow any approach by a wheelchair. Both bathrooms are small; they have a WC and a floor-mounted bidet, a shower cubicle with a 50/70 cm entrance and a 14 cm step. The kitchen is furnished with a 90cm high cooktop and a rectangular table with a useful underneath space of 73cm.

The public beach is reached by a path with a steep slope (greater than 12%) of about 200 meters: the first stretch in asphalt and then, after a turnstile, in sand and beaten earth.

Pets are allowed in the pitches but not in the housing units.

There is a fire alarm with buttons and a megaphone loudspeaker for communication in the event of an emergency inside the campsite.
